Cllr L Williams, raised a query regarding the need for all footpaths in the community to be properly maintained, however there is limited capacity amongst the Ranger service in the County Council. It was noted that in the County Council had suggested that the community council could apply for grants to improve the paths. The Clerk reported that in previous years the County Council had agreed to provide any materials required for path maintenance should the community council be prepared to complete the labour required.

It was suggested that there would be a benefit in trying to establish a walking group in the community with advice provided back to the Clerk of any priority work which could be completed by the caretakers.

Strimmer Equipment

It was reported that both caretakers had successfully completed training on the safe use and maintenance of a strimmer and that Roger Perry had completed training on the use of a chainsaw. As part of the training, it had been outlined that there is a more appropriate cutting head available on the market for cutting around headstones.

Resolved hire a strimmer with this type of head if possible to test the suitability of the product prior to the purchase of a strimmer.

Water boiler

It was reported that the water boiler in the kitchen is not working. Members expressed concern that the availability of a water boiler is encouraging visitors to the hall to enter the kitchen for use of the boiler. **Resolved** to prevent members of the public from obtaining hot water from the kitchen through the provision of insulated jugs which can be provided to visitors as required.

- The accident count signage previously paid for with European funding will be removed as no money is available to update the sign.
- There is a light out in Rhos y Deri.
- Spoke with residents about barriers for Roman Road as there are issues with off road bikers and cattle.
- Heol Bryngwilli street light out..
- HMO Upper Tumble spoke to the Police
