Cofnod rhif 100 – Adolygu'r Cynllun Datblygu Lleol

Cafwyd trosolwg gan y Clerc o'r cynnydd a wnelir gyda'r ymgynghoriad cymunedol ynghylch y Cynllun Datblygu Lleol(CDLI). Nodwyd taw dyma'r rhan gyntaf o broses i ddatblygu 'Cynllun Bro' i'r 3 cymuned, ac ymgynghorir ymhellach dros y misoedd nesaf a fydd canlyniadau'r ymgynghoriad hwn hefyd yn bwydo i mewn i ddatblygu Cynllun Llesiant i'r gymuned. Penderfynwyd bod angen cynnal cyfarfod arbennig i drafod ymgynghoriad y CDLI cyn ein bod yn ymateb i adolygiad y CDLI.

Cofnod rhif 101 – Adroddiadau'r Cynghorwyr Sir

Cafwyd adroddiad gan y Cynghorydd E Dole ynghylch y materion canlynol:

- Llwynteg – Coedwig Grugos – cynhelir cyfarfod cyhoeddus ar ddiwedd y mis yng Nghapel Llwynteg i drafod y cais cynllunio.
- Mae'r Cynghorydd Dole yn ymgynghori gyda Dŵr Cymru ynghylch problem ddŵr yn Rhosyderi sy'n achosi llifogydd.

- Carnival - A problem has been identified with the provision of advertisement signs on statutory signage in the community. The County Council and Police are investigating the need for road closures linked to the carnival procession.
- A request has been received for a notice board to be provided in Tumble. **Resolved to** proceed with the purchase of a noticeboard to be located near Maddocks store. Cllr Dole agreed to assist in identifying an appropriate location and obtaining the consent of the County Council.
- Welsh Government has identified an area entitled the “Western Valleys” which receives specific funding from Welsh Government. A request has been submitted to Welsh Government to include the Aman and Gwendraeth Valleys as a hub as part of this scheme.
- Bryn Tawel – It was confirmed that scooter parking is to be provided at this elderly complex.

Councillor D Jones reported on the following matters:

- The Discount Pram Centre Sign should be removed as the planning appeal has now been dismissed.
- Heol y Morlais - a complaint has been received of weeds on the pavement at this location.
- Bro Dawel – There has been a problem from a burst water main at this location.
- The proposed Zigzags have now been provided outside Tumble School.
- Funding from a section 106 contribution has been provided for the construction of a parking bay adjacent to the Police Station.
- Heol Ddu, Llwynteg – It was reported that residents are happy that the road has been improved in this area.

Minute no. 103 – CDO Report

The CDO entered the meeting and gave a report on the progress of the community consultation exercise. **Resolved to** convene a special meeting of the Council to receive feedback on the information and views gathered in the consultation in anticipation of the Council providing observations to the County Council in relation to the existing Local Development Plan.

The Clerk reported that there is a need to procure some additional tools for the caretakers to assist in various works linked to the transfer of assets. **Resolved to** approve the purchase of the itemised tools plus 1 extra battery.

Minute no. 106 – Cross Hands Park

It was reported that there has been vandalism to the teenage shelter. It was agreed to proceed with acquiring a replacement sheet of polycarbonate and **resolved to** put a photo of the damage and the associated cost of this work on the Council’s website.

Cllr K Thomas reported that it is planned to organise a “Party for the Cross Hands Park” on the 22nd of September. A request has been made for a contribution from the Council to assist in organisation of the event and it was **resolved** that the Council will donate up to £500.00.

Minute no. 108 – Suspending Standing Orders

Resolved to suspend standing orders to continue the transaction of business beyond 9.00 pm.

Minute no. 109 – Reports Continued

Cllr L M Davies raised the following matters:

- There are concerns regarding speeding at Llannon. She has requested that the speed monitoring equipment is amended to a sign indicating car speed.
- Speeding traffic at entry to Tumble – she has requested a similar sign at this location.
- Troedybryn - a complaint has been received regarding the allocation policy for new tenants to this estate.

Cllr N Holman reported on the event that he is promoting on Friday 7th September as an Ambulance/Fire/Police charity ball.

Cllr L Williams informed members that during a recent litter pick at the Family Centre, it was noted that people are using the Family Centre bin for general rubbish. She requested that the County Council provide an additional litter bin near to this location. **Resolved that** the Clerk send a letter to the County Council requesting that a litter bin be provided at this location.

Cllr P Williams informed members that there is no room for ball playing at Singleton Park. It was recommended that there is a need to provide a level area to the park.

Cllr R Thomas informed members that the Cross Hands traffic lights continue to be a problem with people not understanding and adhering to the traffic lights at this location. It was suggested there may be a benefit in straightening the orientation of the lights.

Cllr L Williams reported that she has agreed to be a trustee of the family centre.
