Cofnod rhif 86 – Pabell Fawr

Cafwyd adroddiad ynghylch y pryniad diweddar o'r ddwy babel fawr, a'r defnydd posib o'r pebyll yng ngharnifal Cross Hands.

Cofnod rhif 87 – Parc Cross Hands

Cafwyd trosolwg gan y Clerc o'r trafodaethau a gynhaliwyd gyda swyddogion Cwb Rygbi Cefneithin parthed â'r posibilrwydd o ddefnyddio'r caeau chwarae a'r ystafelloedd newid ym Mharc Cross Hands. Nodwyd hyn.

Minute no. 88 – Erw Non Llannon

The Council received correspondence from Hazel Newman of the County Council regarding a proposal to consider the sale of a plot of land at Erw Non Llannon. An explanation was provided of previous issues at this location including the problem of Japanese Knotweed and drainage problems.

Cllr D Snaith declared an interest in the matter being considered and took no part in the deliberations on the matter.

It was noted that the County Council has enquired as to whether the community council has any interest in the acquisition of the land. It was **resolved** that the Community Council would express an interest in the asset transfer of the land in the event that the residents are not interested in the purchase of land to extend their gardens.

Minute no. 89 – Amman Valley Hospital

The Council received a request for financial assistance from the Amman Valley Hospital Action Group to further the campaign for the retention of the hospital and the provision of X Ray services at the hospital. It was **resolved** that the hospital be offered free use of the Council Marquees as a contribution towards the upcoming event.

Minute no. 90 – Community Lighting Scheme

The Council received correspondence from Carmarthenshire County Council with regard to the lack of future availability of sodium light fittings for the highway lighting which are the responsibility of the Community Council. Information was provided regarding a scheme to renew the sodium fittings with low voltage lights which would result in reduced energy costs and a prolonged life for the bulbs. The cost of the replacement scheme was estimated at £13483.00 with an interest free loan scheme available to cover this cost over a period of 8 years costing £1685.38 per year. The cost of the loan would be set against a predicted energy saving cost of £1959 per year.

After a detailed discussion, it was **resolved** to proceed with the proposed scheme.

Minute no. 91 – Consultation Health Authority

The Council received correspondence from the Health Board regarding proposals to develop alternative trauma services for the community. It was **resolved** to distribute information to individual councillors regarding the proposals in order for them to respond accordingly.

Minute no. 92 – Suspending Standing Orders

Resolved to suspend standing orders in order to continue the transaction of business beyond 9.00 pm.

Minute no. 93 – Hanging Baskets

The Council received information from Roger Perry, one of the Council's caretakers regarding the need for some assistance over the Summer period with the watering of the hanging baskets. It was agreed to proceed with seeking temporary employment to assist the caretakers during peak periods to ensure that the watering duties could be completed safely. It was noted that there continues to be complaints received from members of the public regarding lack of baskets at certain geographical locations. It was further **resolved** to purchase additional baskets as required subject to Cllr P Williams and Cllr W James meeting with the caretakers to agree individual locations for the additional baskets. Any posts which are deemed not to be required in the community or are damaged will be removed.

Cofnod rhif 88 – Erw Non Llannon

Roedd y Cyngor wedi derbyn gohebiaeth oddiwrth Hazel Newman o'r Cyngor Sir parthed â'r cynnig i ystyried gwerthu llain o dir yn Erw Non Llannon. Rhoddwyd esboniad o'r problemau blaenorol a oedd wedi effeithio ar y lleoliad hyn, gan gynnwys problem Clymog Siapan a phroblemau draeniad.

Roedd y Cynghorydd D Snaith wedi datgan buddiant yn y mater dan sylw, ac ni gymerodd unrhyw rhan yn y trafodaethau yngylch y mater.

Nodwyd bod y Cyngor Sir wedi gofyn os oedd gan y Cyngor Cymuned ddiddordeb yn caffael y tir. **Penderfynwyd** y byddai'r Cyngor Cymuned yn datgan diddordeb yn trosglwyddo asedau'r tir os nad oes gan y preswylwyr ddiddordeb mewn prynu'r tir er mwyn ymestyn eu gerddi.

Cofnod rhif 89 – Ysbyty Dyffryn Aman

Roedd y Cyngor wedi derbyn cais am gymorth ariannol oddiwrth Grŵp Gweithredu Ysbyty Dyffryn Aman er mwyn eu galluogi i barhau gyda'u hymgyrch i gadw'r ysbyty ac i ddarparu gwasanaeth pelydr - X yn yr ysbyty. Fel ein cyfraniad at y digwyddiad sydd yn yr arfaeth, **penderfynwyd** cynnig bod yr ysbyty yn cael benthycu Pebyll Mawr y Cyngor am ddim.

Roedd y Cyngor wedi derbyn gohebiaeth oddiwrth Cyngor Sir Caerfyrddin ynghylch diffyg argaeledd goleuadau sodiwm yn y dyfodol ar gyfer y goleuadau ffordd y mae'r Cyngor Cymuned yn gyfrifol amdanynt. Darparwyd gwybodaeth am gynllun i amnewid y goleuadau sodiwm gyda goleuadau o foltedd isel, a byddai hyn yn arwain at leihad yn y costau ynni ac yn golygu bod y bylbiau yn para'n hirach. Amcangyfrifir y byddai'r cynllun amnewid yn costu £13483.00 a byddai cynllun benthycu arian di-log yn cael ei gynnig i dalu'r gost yma yn ôl dros gyfnod o 8 mlynedd, ar gost blynyddol o £1685.38. Byddai cost y benthyciad yn cael ei osod yn erbyn arbediad mewn costau ynni o £1959 y flwyddyn. Wedi trafodaeth fanwl, **penderfynwyd** bwrw ymlaen gyda'r cynllun arfaethedig.

Cofnod rhif 92 – Atal y Rheolau Sefydlog

Penderfynwyd atal y rheolau sefydlog fel bod modd parhau i ystyried busnes y Cyngor ar ôl 9.00 yh.

Cofnod rhif 93 – Basgedi Crog

Roedd y Cyngor wedi derbyn gwybodaeth oddiwrth Roger Perry, un o ofalwyr y Cyngor, parthed â'r angen am gymorth i ddyfrio'r basgedi crog dros gyfnod yr haf. Cytunwyd mynd ati i gyflogi person dros-dro i helpu'r gofalwyr yn ystod cyfnodau brig i sicrhau bod y dyfrio'n cael ei wneud mewn ffordd ddiogel. Nodwyd ein bod yn dal i dderbyn cwynion oddiwrth aelodau'r cyhoedd parthed â'r diffyg basgedi crog mewn rhai lleoliadau daearyddol. Hefyd, **penderfynwyd** prynu rhagor o fasgedi yn ôl y galw, yn amodol ar bod y Cynghorydd P Williams a'r Cynghorydd W James yn cwrdd â'r gofalwyr i gytuno ar leoliadau unigol ar gyfer y basgedi ychwanegol. Bydd unrhyw byst y tybir eu bod yn ddiangen yn y gymuned, neu sydd wedi'u difrodi, yn cael eu tynnu i ffordd.

Minute no. 94 – Caretakers

The Clerk reported that concern had been expressed by the caretakers regarding a complaint that had been received from a member of the public relating to the fact that Tir Waun park was cut on 2 occasions with a photograph taken of him doing the cutting. It was noted that the caretakers considered this an invasion of their privacy and in fact the complaint was unfounded.

The council offered its full support to the caretakers and Councillors agreed to communicate with the complainant accordingly.

Minute no. 95 – Councillor Reports

Councillor D Jones reported that she has received a request for the Council to take part in a video recording that there remain only 5 days before the carnival. It was agreed that the Council will produce a video at the end of the meeting.

Cllr M Jones expressed concern regarding security arrangements for the hall when the alarm is triggered. It was noted that the Council has previously agreed to provide a link between the Hall CCTV system and the mobile phones of the staff, and it was agreed that this should be actioned as soon as possible to reduce the risk to staff in the event of an intruder in the hall.

Cllr D Snaith requested that the Council consider planting wildflower seeds on a triangular site at Heol Morlais/Bedw Non, Llannon. Cllr D Jones agreed to follow this up with the County Council.

Cllr L Davies enquired as to who has rights to make amendment to the Tumble Hall facebook accounts. It was agreed that both Cllr L Davies and Cllr L Williams will be given administration rights to the Facebook pages.

Cllr W James stated that the path at Mortuary Road is overgrown. Although this is not the responsibility of the Community Council, it was agreed that the caretakers will clear the path. He also reported that the bus stop sign has been removed at 18 Gwendraeth Road and that there is a need to cut the hedge as located between number 16-18 Gwendraeth Road Tumble. Cllr D Jones agreed to follow this up with the County Council.

Minute no. 96 – Urgent Matters during Summer Recess

It was **resolved** that the Chairman would be granted plenary powers to deal with any urgent matters over the summer period.
