Minute No.4 – Sharing ideas and deciding on projects for 2022-2023

RD mentioned the cleaning up after your dog signs that she has made for Mynydd Mawr Country Park and requested LCC consider doing the same.

LD proposed that the council uses the same signs with LCC logo. Get the schools involved and asked the children to make posters for the schools. Put coke bottles and filled them with poo bags. In September do something more official. Make a start with the family centre.

LD suggested a competition could be run on FB.

LW noted the need to purchase official signs also.

RD posters, Clare to print and Environment Committee will put up.

LW advised some jobs need to be addressed in Parc Tyisha. The pergola needs to be painted. The path needs to be sprayed and cleared. A bench needs to be positioned and compost moved.

LD noted the gates are locked and could parked cars be addressed.

LW suggested signs as to where the path goes/develop footpaths.

A volunteer morning was suggested but it was agreed to leave Tyisha until the Spring

LD suggested that a SEED PLANTING DAY/INSECT HOTEL would be good – choose a place for the beds so weed suppressant could be put down. Committee agreed to meet on Saturday morning at 9.30am onsite to discuss further.

LW noted the Places for nature funding– need to show maintenance, volunteers. Wildlife garden, in the wood by EGE house.

LW asked about her request regarding the Keep Wales Tidy grant – Clare to speak to Paul.

It was agreed that dog fouling be the Committee's priority for 2022-23.

EGE – very keen for a walk to go ahead. LD stated a ramblers "Pound the Path". "Beat the Path Day" could be an option. EGE will put together a walk.
