Report of the Chair of Llannon Community Council for May, June and July 2023

In addition to attending the Council's committee meetings and translating documents into Welsh as required I have taken part in the following events during the months of May, June and July:

19.05.23 : **Inauguration of Mayor of Cwmwman Town Council** with Councillor Phil Owen.

20.05.23 : **Tumble Colts' Football Festival** - presenting medals.

25.05.23 : **Ten Towns' Circular Economy Event** in St Clears with Councillors Ruth Lloyd Davies and Llinos Davies, which included :

- Dr Sioned Haf : A summary of Afallen's consultation with the 10 Towns on the the Circular Economy.
- Representatives from a number of the towns sharing experiences and information regarding their eco projects, eg. repair cafes, re-cycling fabrics, food hubs, community gardens.
- Cwm Environmental : The ETO project and supporting mini-ECOs in the 10 Towns.

07.06.23 : **Spring Wild Flower Walk** in Parc Coetir y Mynydd Mawr led by Councillor Ruth Lloyd Davies.

27.06.23 : **Cross Hands Park** as Nursery and Reception classes from Cross Hands Primary school used the new play equipment for the first time.

05.07.23 : **One Voice Wales Conference on *Innovative Practice - Facing the Challenges of a Demanding Future.***

Councillor Ruth Lloyd Davies and I attended this excellent conference in Llanelwedd. Here is a synopsis of the presentations:

- Rebecca Evans MS, Minister for Finance and Local Government: Welsh Government's vision of the role of community and town councils in the coming years.
- Clare Sain-Ley-Berry, Interim Director, Cynnal Cymru: Support and guidance for the sustainability journey.
- Bleddyn Lake, Friends of the Earth Cymru Campaigns and Development Manager : Facing the challenges of climate change - practical steps that can be taken at the local level.
- Brian Brookes, BHIB Insurance : Risk Assessment - the requirements in relation to insurance including legal expenses cover.
- Paul Egan, Deputy Chief Executive One Voice Wales : Ensuring that training

supports the realisation of Council objectives and competency development.

There was then an opportunity to divide into groups for further training:

08.07.23 : **Afternoon tea to celebrate Glanaman Community Hospital's 75th birthday** with Councillor Phil Owen.

The celebrations were opened by Mrs Aneira Thomas, who was born in this hospital, the first baby in Britain to be born under the National Health Service.

12.07.23 : **Cross Hands Growth Group meeting** with Councillors Ruth Lloyd Davies and Llinos Davies. (Councillor D.Jones chairing).

There is still significant funding available to develop Cross Hands as one of the Ten Towns. As the local business community has not proposed a project the fund is now open to local community groups which have a formal constitution. Interest must be declared and a project outlined by 09.08.23.

One Voice Wales Area Committee meeting (on zoom) with Councillor Ruth Lloyd Davies.

County Councillor Aled Vaughan Owen gave a presentation on environmental issues and described what Carmarthenshire Council is doing to face the challenge of climate change. A discussion followed.

Councils then shared news and good practice. I reported our exciting news regarding Cross Hands Play Park and the Safe Routes to Schools scheme, and gave an update on the Cwtsh.

19.07.23 : **Tumble Family Centre** - with Councillor Ruth Lloyd Davies. We attended the Hall at the request of the trustees to speak to Ms Sara Powys who was gathering information on Early Years provision in Carmarthenshire on behalf of the County Council.

20.07.23 : **One Voice Wales training** on Local Government Finance - with Councillors Llinos Davies and Nigel Thomas.
