Photo ID is not required in Scottish Parliament and Senedd elections, or local elections and by-elections in Scotland and Wales.

A wide range of photo ID will be accepted, including passports, driving licences and cards with a PASS mark. The name on your ID should be the same name you used to register to vote. If you don't have an accepted form of ID, you can apply for a free voter ID document known as a Voter Authority Certificate.

Flying Start

In March 2022 Welsh Government under the Programme For Government priorities, announced a commitment to deliver a phased expansion of early years provision to all 2 year olds with particular emphasis on Welsh medium provision. This expansion is to be rolled out in a phased approach over a 10 year period. Welsh Government require Flying Start to target communities in deprived areas that are not already part of the Flying Start programme. Families will become eligible for childcare through their home address postcode as their areas become included in the phased expansion. Flying Start is now in the process of expanding into Lower Super Output Areas (LSOA) - **Llannon 1** and **Llannon 2** (see maps). Postcode eligibility can be checked on the [Flying Start Carmarthenshire - Carmarthenshire Family Information Service \(gov.wales\)](#).

➤ Capital Development Fund

As part of the 10 Towns programme, vacant premises across the County's rural market towns could be eligible for financial support of up to £50,000 to re-develop premises in the town

centre which are currently in a state of disrepair and not being utilised. This is a targeted fund for premises located in designated areas of each rural market town. Applications from premises located outside of each town's designated area may be considered on a case-by-case basis should the project provide significant impact.

Applications must be submitted no later than **31 March 2024**
